Dogs must be registered with SDDA and be over six (6) months of age.

Entry limits: A handler may enter a maximum of one dog in each component for this event.

Entry fees: \$35 per Component entry (Advanced & Excellent); \$100 for all 3 components of Elite

Entry confirmations: Confirmations will be emailed upon acceptance, please allow 24-48 hours.

Entry method: First come basis for regular entries

Payment: Once your entry space is confirmed, payment must be received within 72 hours to hold your space (10 days for payment by cheque). Payment details will be sent with confirmation email; payment accepted by cheque or E-Transfer.

Refunds: Refunds will only be issued if we can fill your space from a wait list. A five dollar (\$5) processing fee per refund transaction will be withheld



Awards: Qualifying ribbons per component pass, and rosettes for first time titles.

Participant Information:

Training and/or unofficial use of odour is NOT PERMITTED on trial grounds.

DOGS: Dogs must be under control at all times. Do not allow your dog(s) to pee on anything manmade. Pick up after your dog(s) immediately. Dogs must be on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Do not allow your dog to approach other dogs or people without explicit permission. If you wish extra room please put a red bandana on your dog to signal this to others.

Running Order: running order will be decided by random draw. Order will be posted at check-in.

Bitches in heat: bitches in heat are allowed to compete and will run last in each component level. **We ask that you notify us ASAP if your bitch is in heat so we can adjust the running order.** Bitches in heat must wear pants.

Food: March 30 & 31: restaurants & fast-food outlets are within easy walking distance.
April 1: limited fast food options near the trial site (about 10 min drive). You may want to bring your own packed lunch.

Crating: Crating will be in your vehicle. Bring appropriate equipment to keep your dog(s) comfortable.
